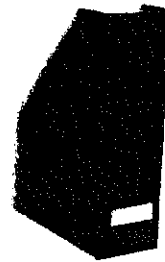


Mr. Capizzi's First Grade Supply List

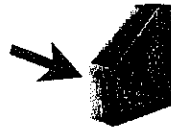

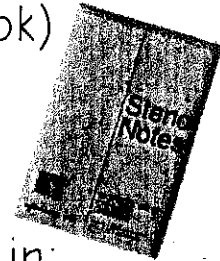

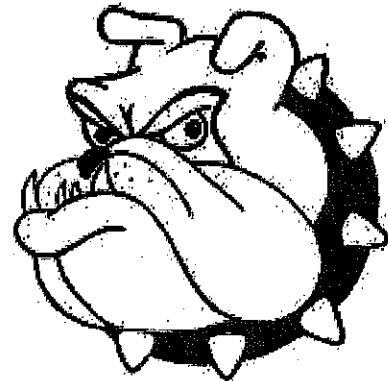

7 West Supplies List

Dear Parents:

We would like to welcome you and your child to an exciting year on 7 West at North Kirkwood Middle School. We have one major goal . . . SUCCESS! This goal can be achieved through consistency with attendance, good study habits, acceptable classroom behavior, academic achievement, and organizational skills. To provide help with organization, each student needs to be prepared for the first day of 7th grade with the following materials.

3 inch three-ring binder and colored plastic tab dividers

Zippered pencil pouch for supplies

2 boxes of pencils or erasable pens (no ballpoint pens and no red ink please)

Composition notebook*

Grid or quad-ruled spiral notebook with at least 100 pages*

Box of colored pencils

1 box of markers

1 pack of highlighter

10 glue sticks

16 GB USB flash drive

Scissors (one pair at home/one pair at school)

2 boxes or more of tissues

1 black Sharpie

1 Stylist for iPad

Ear buds

2 packs of 3x5 index cards

Optional (but recommended)

Suggestions:

Plastic tab dividers with sleeves for handouts
